ITEM I - WELCOME ADDRESS

ITEM II - BRIEF REPORT - PRINCIPAL, JNTUHCEH

Principal JNTUH College of Engineering Hyderabad made a brief presentation of the progress report and the action taken on the decisions taken in the 2nd BoG meeting and implementation thereof. With regards to Orientation of faculty towards patents it was decided to conduct training programs on patent application filing.
