Item 4: Accreditation status

Two departments have to upload SAR for UG department. Chairman questioned SFR and Dr.E.Hari has enquired about the problem.

Item 5: Status of NAAC preparation

NAAC is very essential for fund mobilization hence gear up and register for NAAC.

Item 6: Strategy plan for 3-5 years

Principal has to consolidate all departments' strategic plans and need to mailed to BoG members.

Dr.E.Hari has suggested setting a road map with milestones and including contributors/task force for that milestone.

Plan for fund from industry (CSR), every department can set up labs in collaboration with industry.

Dr E.Hari has suggested department level CSR coordinators to invite industry and attract CSR funds.

Prof.N.C.Shivaprakash Chairman, BoG has suggested to visit Hubbali college to witness 45 start-up in campus and promote start-up culture at our college.

Dr.E.Hari has informed HDCSE the need a mobile app for alumni global group– smart group in new jersey on AI to be connected with CSE department.

Alumni coordinator has explained the activities – industry internships / industry mentors for teaching elective subjects (10-20%) – collecting success story.

Prof.A.Govardhan, Rector, JNTUH has referred father-child chain component of OU website requested alumni coordinator to incorporate that feature.

Prof.A.Govardhan, Rector, JNTUH has enquired about Global alumni meeting coordinator informed it is on 21st Dec 2019.
