Note:

- a. This Notification is issued for the candidates who have studied in JNTUH College of Engineering Hyderabad, Institute of Science & Technology(IST) and School of information Technology(SIT) ONLY.
- b. This Notification is issued for the candidates who have completed their maximum course duration as per the academic regulations (i.e., B.Tech(Reg) – 8 years, B.Tech.(IDP,IDDMP,IIDDMP) – 10 years, M.Tech./MCA/M.Sc – 4 years, M.Tech.(PTPG)/MCA – 6 years) who could not complete for the award degree.
- c. Students who have been detained in a Subject/Semester due to Shortage of attendance are **NOT ELIGIBLE TO AVAIL ONE TIME CHANCE EXAMINATION** in that subject/course.
- d. To avail the opportunity, it is mandatory for the candidate to appear for the External Examination of that particular subject/course.
- e. **IMPROVEMENT OF INTERNAL MARKS:**A student is eligible to improve the internal marks in a particular subject/course if**For UG : Internal Marks are less than or equal to 16, For PG : Internal Marks are less than or equal to 22**
 - To avail this opportunity, it is mandatory for the candidate to appear for the External Examination of that particular subject/course.
 - If the new internal marks are less than old internal marks, then the old internal marks will be retained.
 - Only one mid-term examination shall be conducted for 30 marks for 2Hrs covering the WHOLE SYLLABUS
 - The mid-term question paper consists of 10 questions (two questions from each unit). The student shall answer any 5 questions out of 10 questions. All the questions carry equal marks.
- f. Applications can be obtained from the Examination Branch of JNTUH UCESTH.
- g. The filled in application form along with **Bank Challan & Xerox copy of Marks Memo of the appearing Subject** should be submitted in the Examination Branch of JNTUH UCESTH **On or BEFORE THE LAST DATE** as mentioned above.
- h. The candidates can give authorization letter (by email) to his/her parent/guardian/friend to pay the fee and submit the application.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1) After writing the INTERNAL EXAM for internal marks improvement, is it necessary to write the Special supplementary (one-time chance) semester-end exam?

Yes. It is compulsory to register and write the special supplementary (one-time-chance) semester-end examinations after the INTERNAL EXAM. The final marks will be calculated based on the scores from both the INTERNAL EXAM and the semester-end examination of Special supplementary (one-time-chance) exams.

2) Can I pass the backlog subject considering present improvement internal marks through INTERNAL EXAM this time with earlier external marks?

No, if there is an improvement in internals marks compared to earlier internal marks then the current and subsequent special supplementary (one-time-chance) end examinations marks will be considered for passing the subject.

3) Are the previous internal marks will be deleted if the marks secured in the present INTERNAL EXAM are less (or) registered for INTERNAL EXAM but not appeared?

No, if the new marks are less than the old internal marks (or) registered but not attended INTERNAL EXAM, the old internal marks will be retained, as it is an internal improvement examination.

4) Whether the students who write special INTERNAL EXAM followed by special supplementary (one-time-chance) exam are eligible for grace marks/credit exemption?

Yes, students who write the INTERNAL EXAM followed by special supplementary (one-time-chance) semester- end exam are eligible for grace marks as well as undertaking as per the academic regulations prevailing during the period of study of their course work.

5) Special Supplementary (One Time Chance) INTERNAL EXAM meant for both UG and PG courses?

Yes, Both UG & PG students can apply for INTERNAL EXAM for improvement in internal marks.

6) Are the PG students who passed all the subjects but did not submit project works are eligible to register for project viva exams?

Yes, PG students are eligible to register for the project viva exam.
